Instructions for the presentation of the qualifications and the research project required by the call for application

1) Research Project. The research project must be submitted as pdf file.

The research project must concern a topic of significant scientific interest in one of the following research areas identified by the Scientific Disciplinary Sectors (SSD) consistent with the educational objectives of the PhD Program:

- Endocrinology and metabolic diseases (MED/05 -General and Clinical Pathology)
- Internal Medicine (MED/09 – Internal Medicine)
- Immunology (MED/09 – Internal Medicine)
- Geriatrics (MED/09 – Internal Medicine)
- Cardiovascular diseases (MED/11 – Cardiovascular System Diseases)
- Odontostomatology (MED/28: Odontostomatologic Diseases)
- Dermatology (MED/35: Dermatologic Diseases)
- Pediatrics (MED/38: General and Specialized Pediatrics and Child Neuropsychiatry).

It is mandatory that candidates use the facsimile provided to prepare their research project. Candidates are required to respect the indicated space limits in all sections (research projects in which one or more sections exceed the limits indicated will be negatively evaluated). The evaluation of the research project has the sole purpose of evaluating the aptitudes of candidates for scientific research and not that of evaluating the originality of research projects for participation in competitive calls. Therefore, while submitting their research project, the candidate will have to sign a waiver of intellectual property rights on the submitted research project. In the absence of this declaration at the bottom of the project, the project will not be evaluated. After completing all the sections, the candidate must enter the date, sign the research project, and convert the file into pdf format (the only file format accepted).

2) Documentation required for online application

The documentation required for the call application and the research project (prepared as described at point 1) must be sent by candidates in electronic format exclusively through the electronic procedure indicated in the call for application published on the website of University of Naples Federico II.
